## Technical details:

- Logos may use any colour scheme, but the logo should look good in colour as well as in grayscale representations.
- As mentioned above, submissions should be in PDF format (at least 600 DPI resolution).
- Logos should be easily scalable; in particular, they should still be recognizable at small scales and at relatively low resolutions.
